COURSE NOTES

Course Text: The Book of Song Dances by John M. Feierabend

While some students may naturally pick up quickly on the songs and dances, doing two things at once requires coordination which comes with time and practice. Always encourage best effort and celebrate progress over perfection.

We encourage you to work through each dance slowly and intentionally. The focus should be to apply skills being learned in music lessons to singing and recognizing rhythm, as well as accurately moving the body at just the right time. Teach the song lyrics (recognizing rhythm), then dance (applying rhythm), and then combine the two. We recommend that the teacher learn the dance first using the videos provided and then teach it to the students.

We have provided audio recordings of the songs in SoundCloud: piano accompaniment only and voice with piano. Each version has a short piano introduction. We have also provided video instruction in Vimeo for teachers to the dance steps.
